The mission of the Oneida Education Foundation is to encourage business and community involvement in our schools and to actively seek supplemental resources to assure SUCCESS FOR EVERY STUDENT in the Oneida County School District.

The Oneida Education Foundation was established in 1988 to raise funds for Oneida County Schools. The OEF provides a channel by which individuals and businesses may donate money to the schools and receive tax benefits as well as the satisfaction of having assisted the Oneida County schools, teachers, and students. It is a nonprofit organization that functions independently of the Oneida School Board and District while cooperating with school officials to benefit teachers and students. The OEF operates under its own by-laws and elects its own board members and officers. Each school in the district has a representative on the board; the majority of board members are community members, all of whom serve as volunteers. The board meets monthly to plan its grant-giving and fund-raising projects.

OEF PRIORITIES FOR GRANT GIVING

The OEF Board has the following priorities for the awarding of grants:

- 1) Classroom/curriculum grants for supplies, materials, and equipment 65%
- 2) Scholarships 30%
- 3) Grants for co-curricular activities 5%

The endowment will fund scholarships for students interested in government or public service or who plan to major in business or political science in college.
